- 2019 VASSE FELIX SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARGARET RIVER, WA** **55.0**  
*Pale straw in colour with a golden tinge. Orange zest, jasmine, savoury cheddar and cedar with wafts of limestone cliffs and coaster herb. Crystalline acidity balanced by a soft, pure texture. Savoury elements of river stone, hints of citrus peel and a beautiful lemon tang. 95 pts*

*Delicious sauvignon blanc with fragrant lemon, citrus, wild flowers, white peach and stone fruit flavours. It has a truly ethereal texture and gentle, fruity acidity. Power delivered with great subtlety. Wonderful purity.*
- 2021 ROWLEE SINGLE VINEYARD FUME BLANC, ORANGE, NSW** **62.5**

*Classic, cool-climate-style Pinot Gris showing lifted citrus notes with a hint of pear & ginger. The palate continues these citrus & pear flavours with the lovely fine-grained texture & soft acid finish that are hallmarks of the variety. Light & fresh with a hint of spice.*
- 2017 THE IMPRESSIONIST PINOT GRIGIO, EDEN VALLEY, SA** **37.5**  
*Light, Mixed aromas of Nashi pear and citrus blossom, with a tight mineral mid-palate structure, fresh and well-rounded tropical fruit notes are supported by a crisp and vibrant finish*
- 2021 BLEASDALE PINOT GRIS, ADELAIDE HILLS, SA** **40.0**  
*There is both flavour and texture complexity, largely nashi pear and citrus, plus tropical and spice slants. 94pts – 2021 JH Top 100 wines*

*Opulent & stylish, golden peach, poached pear, spice & rich floral aromas on the nose, leading to a succulent palate that is wonderfully weighted & creamy. Layers of silky texture & expansive mouthfeel, enhanced with subtle sweetness, leading to an impressively long velvety finish. 94 pts*
- 2019 THE OTHER WINE CO. PINOT GRIS, ADELAIDE HILLS, SA** **50.0**  
*Juicy, spicy & textured. Strong pear & apple characters with citrus blossom & honeysuckle notes on the nose. Palate packed with ripe apple & pear. Fleshy & textural with great density of flavour & acid balance as well as grainy pear skin phenolics. 93 pts*

## *Pinot Gris and Grigio*

- 2021 KANGARILLA PINOT GRIGIO, ADELAIDE HILLS, SA** **55.0**  
*Familiar aromas of brown lime cordial with undertones of fresh cut pineapple & orange blossom. On tasting there is mouth watering zingy acidity carrying subtle fruit salad flavours with lemon sherbet & schweppes bitter lemon through to a lovely textual finish.*
- 2021 ATA RANGI, LISMORE PINOT GRIS, MARTINBOROUGH, NZ** **75.0**  
*Complex pinot gris with ripe tree fruits, pear, apple and a seasoning of roast chestnut, ginger and mandarin blossom. Intriguing and attractive wine in a dry(ish) style. A delicious wine that's ready now. 95 pts*
- 2019 DOMAINE SCHLUMBERGER, GRAND CRUS "KESSLER" PINOT GRIS, ALSACE, FR** **100.0**  
*A ripe & candied nose with bright, yellow fruits: quince, plum, honey & a light smokiness. Luscious palate with a luscious sweetness & creamy mouthfeel. Botrytised grapes bring an apricot marmalade character with yellow fruit & honeyed tones, all balanced by a linear acidity.*
- 2016 DRY RIVER PINOT GRIS, MARTINBOROUGH, NZ** **120.0**  
*Ripe, rich pinot gris with tree fruit, peach, nectarine, tropical fruit, pineapple and subtle spice and anise flavours. A hint of sweetness is balanced by fine, peppery tannins. A concentrated and appealing wine with cellaring potential. 95 pts*

## *Chardonnay*

- 2021 TAMBURLAINE "WINE LOVERS" CHARDONNAY, ORANGE, NSW** **42.5**  
*Apple blossom and lemon aromas on the nose, while on the palate, crisp green apple and white nectarine fruits, with vibrant acidity*
- 2021 TYRRELLS HUNTER VALLEY CHARDONNAY, HUNTER VALLEY, NSW** **45.0**  
*Medium-bodied Hunter Valley Chardonnay, the nose shows a great mixture of citrus, white stone fruit, some oak spice as well as a hint of solids complexity. The palate is medium bodied, with a lively fruit intensity and texture through the mid-palate, with a refreshing acid profile.*
- 2021 HILL SMITH EDEN VALLEY CHARDONNAY, EDEN VALLEY, SA** **45.0**  
*Pale straw with green tints. Fragrant aromas of fresh peach, quince and citrus zest with subtle hints of French oak and flint from wild yeast fermentation. Flavours of fresh stone fruit and citrus curd are underpinned by fresh grapefruit acidity and a fine creamy texture. 93 pts*
- 2020 DOMAINE NATURALISTE DISCOVERY CHARDONNAY, MARGARET RIVER, WA** **47.5**  
*Fermentation and maturation in mainly seasoned French Oak which adds complexity and generosity of texture without compromising the purity of aromatics or flavour. Seven months in French oak sur lie. 13%alcohol. Fruit purity, perfume, texture.*
- 2022 SWINGING BRIDGES "MRS PAYTON" CHARDONNAY, ORANGE, NSW** **52.5**  
*Light to mid-yellow colour and a spicy bouquet that reflects some smart oak maturation. The wine is very lively in the mouth with bright and slightly shrill acidity. Lots of lemon flavour here, good intensity and vivacious fruit-and-acid interplay. Long carry. An appetising and moreish chardonnay. 92 pts*
- 2017 BLOODWOOD CHARDONNAY, ORANGE, NSW** **60.0**  
*Fresh green gold in colour, gently savoury-textured, rainwater-soft palate fleshy with nectarine and melon fruit notes. flinty minerality and purity of varietal expression, generously refreshing*
- 2019 LA CREMA MONTEREY CHARDONNAY, MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA** **65.0**  
*Aromas of Meyer lemon, grilled pineapple, and guava are followed by flavors of nectarine, papaya, and lemon-tangerine, with touches of spice and minerality. The palate is rich, opulent, fat and round, with velvety texture and lots of flavour The balanced acidity lingers on a long finish. Full oak and buttery*
- 2020 LITTLE REDDIE MALMSBURY CHARDONNAY, MACENDON RANGES, VIC** **75.0**  
*First waft is all honey and treacle & spring flowers. palate is engulfing & generous in the first sip - sweet meyer lemon, ripe apricot, brioche. The texture is mouth coating, comforting & pleasantly oily with a persistent mineral grip & sufficient acid to call you back for another sip.*
- 2019 HEIRLOOM VINEYARDS, ASSEN'S FORTALICE CHARDONNAY, ADELAIDE HILLS, SA** **80.0**  
*Pale green and gold straw in colour. Aromatics are dominated by white peach and yellow nectarine, highly perfumed. Silky yet structured; fruit depth and richness yet undercut with a shining stainless steel rail of clear, bell-like, acidity. A fresh rainwater front palate quickly*
- 2012 TARRAWARRA ESTATE RESERVE CHARDONNAY, CELLAR RELEASE, YARRA VALLEY, VIC** **80.0**  
*If you wish to see the extreme length & longevity of Yarra Valley chardonnay, go no further. This lovely self-possessed wine is on its plateau of perfection, & will hold its form for years (5+) to come. The freshness of its finish & lingering aftertaste is its ace-in-the-hole. 97 pts – 2021 JH Top 100*

## Chardonnay

- 2017 CURLY FLAT CHARDONNAY, MACEDON RANGES, VIC 90.0**  
*This has punch and weight in equal measure. Fuller-bodied with stone fruit, lemony tones, creamy and very moreish thanks to its restrained nutty/leesy flavours. There's complexity and a vibrancy to the acidity as it glides effortlessly to its long finish 95pts*
- 2018 TYRRELLS VAT 47 CHARDONNAY, HUNTER VALLEY, NSW 100.0**  
*The nose is delicate, showing some nice florals & white stone fruit with only a hint of oak. The palate exhibits an intensity & length not often seen in other Chardonnays. Impeccably balanced between primary fruit characters, some secondary lees components & the fine-grained French oak 96 pts*
- 2017 CHARDONNAY BY FARR, GEELONG, VIC 120.0**  
*Gorgeous, integrated nose of classy oak over white peach, fresh pineapple & lemon, with grilled nuts. Medium-bodied, slippery textured, sleek, oak there but in lovely balance. Very good, integrated length & immediately ready to return for another sip. 95 pts*
- 2020 FELTON ROAD BLOCK 6 CHARDONNAY, BANNOCKBURN, NZ 125.0**  
*Stone fruit, lemon and white blossom. The mouthfeel opens broadly, then coats and intrigues with mineral and refined summer fruit characters. Purposeful, deftly handled and not a step out of place. The naturally low yielding 2020 vintage has provided fruit of great depth and texture. 95 pts*
- 2006 TYRRELLS VAT 47 CHARDONNAY, HUNTER VALLEY, NSW (MUSEUM RELEASE) 150.0**  
*Rich chardonnay and white nectarine stone fruit characters on the nose and throughout the entire palate, with an underlying savoury lift from subtle oak usage. French style "flintiness" to the wine, making it more complex and interesting. Nice balanced and tight wine style with lingering fresh acidity that has aged well*
- 2016 VINCENT GIRARDIN CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 'LES VIEILLES' MEURSAULT, FRANCE 200.0**  
*Bright lemon-yellow with a green tinge. Pure, fresh & bright aromas of lemon, river pebbles & a hint of fresh herbs. Tightly wound, with an edge of acidity to the fresh lemon flavour. A delightful zippy village Chassagne.*

## Full Bodied Whites

- 2019 TELLURIAN BLANC, HEATHCOTE, VIC 42.5**  
*Marsanne, Fiano & Riesling. Fresh, lively, yet complex white wine; with Marsanne providing richer fruit, expressive flavour & rounded texture, while the Fiano and Riesling offer fresher, lighter flavours & texture. Stonefruit-like flavour with honeysuckle, spice and mineral characters*
- 2021 MOUNT MACLEOD GRUNER VELTLINER, GIPPSLAND, VIC 47.5**  
*It's a striking, savoury dry white with intense white pepper and green plum aromas and flavours, along with something exotic akin to guava or even rosewater. It's got texture but it's overall very racy, with a sappy, cool close.*
- 2018 PRECIOUS LITTLE WINE LOBETHAL GRUNER VELTLINER, ADELAIDE HILLS, SA 50.0**  
*Aromas of pear, lime & orange blossom with hints of mandarin & spice. Nicely rounded & vibrant the palate features pear & lime over infusions of orange with a fresh flinty mineral finish. Crisp and dry with a long pear, lime, orange and flinty mineral aftertaste. 94 pts*
- 2016 WENGUT BERNHARD OTT GEMISCHTER SATZ, WAGRAM, AUSTRIA 52.5**
